"Theology" (Theos-God) (Logos-words) - "Words about God" What are your words about God?

Check out these words about God:

These death penalty verses: Numbers 15:32-36; Deuteronomy 13:6-9; Exodus 22:20; Deuteronomy 21:18-

21; Exodus 35:2; Leviticus 21:9

These genocide verses: Deuteronomy 20:16-18; Joshua 6:20-21

These anger verses: 2 Samuel 24:15

How do you resolve the moral dilemmas presented by these "words about God"?

Now check out 1 John 4:7-8. What stands out to you about this passage? Why do you think John wrote "God IS love" instead of merely saying that "God is loving"?

Read 1 Corinthians 13:4-7 and substitute the word "God" for "love" to find out who God is and how God is.

Check out 1 John 1:5. To whom does the author refer to get his picture of God?

Read the following statement: God is not like the Bible. God is like Jesus. What does that statement do to you?

Read these verses and then read that statement again: John 5:39; Hebrews 1:1-3; John 6:46; John 1:18 Ok, what should be the basis of our formulating our view of God?

What would you say to the guy who said this: "I can hang with Jesus. He's the friend I've always wanted. But I'm afraid of God: He wants to kick my ass!"?

Why do some people struggle accepting that God is like Jesus? How does 2 Corinthians 3:14 help explain the struggle?

Has your view of God changed over the years? Does it need to change?
